# Eisenhower Elementary School

VANCOUVER

Eisenhower Elementary will have 27 classrooms grouped into four pods. Each pod will surround a large common co-op area to serve the classrooms. Upper-level pods receive natural light through large translucent skylights. The facility will include faculty and administrative offices, a gymnasium and a large activity room with a motorized operable wall to serve as a lunchroom and for school programs and community functions. The building also features a state-of-the-art media center, music and art areas and a work room to prepare classroom instruction and special projects. The school grounds are surrounded by play areas and a covered play structure. The brick and glass building is enhanced by an adjacent community park developed simultaneously with Eisenhower Elementary.
