# Evergreen High School Remodel

VANCOUVER

This marks the third remodel and addition for Evergreen High School, which was built in four phases from 1970 to 1974. Evergreen Public Schools felt a complete remodel was necessary to better serve the students of the 21st century. The project includes remodeling the existing 222,272-square-foot facility and adding 54,142 square feet of new construction. Features include improvements to an existing auditorium, new locker rooms, an additional gym, a new interior amphitheater and major security upgrades. The remodel allows the school to be reconfigured into five academies within the high school: Business, Computer, Information Technology Academy; Health Science and Human Services Academy; Architectural, Construction, Mechanical, Engineering Academy; Arts and Communications Academy; and Ninth Grade Academy. Parking facilities, drop-off zones and emergency access will also be improved.
